I.0 GENERAL MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Minimum entry requirements for all programmes are as follows:

- 5 CSEC (CXC) General Proficiency and/or Technical Proficiency subjects inclusive of mathematics and English A, grades I, II and III*
 *Grade III accepted if attained in June 1998 and beyond
- OR 5 GCE O'Level subjects inclusive of mathematics and English Language (Grades A, B or C) or equivalent

Please note that standard entry requirements to certain programmes may vary according to the demands of specific disciplines. Applicants should consult the relevant programme brochure or contact the Admissions Office at 625-5030 Ext. 5900 or admissions@costaatt.edu.tt for further details.

Applicants with advanced level subjects (e.g. CAPE, GCE A'Levels) may be considered for advanced standing or award of credit.

2.0 QUALIFICATIONS

All applicants must submit the following for the application to be considered:

- Originals and copies of CSEC (CXC) and/or GCE O'Level certificates or equivalent.
- Originals and copies of CAPE and/or A'Level certificates or equivalent.
- Originals and copies of birth certificate and one form of photo ID (either identification card or passport) - T&T nationals only.
- Originals and copies of passport (all other applicants).

PLEASE KEEP PHOTOCOPIES OF THE FORM AND ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION FOR YOUR RECORDS.

2.I MATURE ENTRY

Mature applicants (25 years and over) who do not possess the minimum entry requirements and wish to be considered on the basis of experience and demonstrable competence, must submit a resume detailing relevant work and voluntary experience.

2.2 TRANSFER APPLICANTS AND ADVANCED STANDING

In addition to (2.0) above, transfer applicants must submit official copies of transcripts of all subjects completed at prior tertiary level institution(s).

Applicants wishing to transfer to COSTAATT with advanced standing must submit the following along with the application form:

- Official transcripts of all subjects previously completed at a tertiary level institution.
- Copies of syllabus/course outlines for courses completed.
- A completed Request for Transfer Credit form, which is available at the Admissions Office.

The College evaluates the transcripts of transfer students to determine equivalency with its own programmes and requirements for graduation. Please note that, depending on the programme of study, there is a limit to the number of credits that may be transferred or the number of

exemptions that may be granted. Transfer applicants must be in good academic standing at the previous institution. Please contact the Admissions Office for further information.

2.3 CARICOM & INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

In addition to (2.0) above, CARICOM and international applicants must submit official copies of transcripts of all subjects completed at prior secondary and tertiary institutions. If these documents are not in English, a certified translation is required. It may also be necessary to have the qualifications assessed by the Accreditation Council of Trinidad & Tobago (ACTT) or the Curriculum Planning and Development Division (CPDD), Ministry of Education.

Qualifications supplied will be assessed to determine equivalence to programme entry requirements.

2.4 ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Applicants whose first language is not English must provide evidence of proficiency in English via an internationally recognized English Language test, such as the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System). Please see our website for minimum test scores required.

4.0 NON-MATRICULATED APPLICANTS

Students interested in earning credit for specific college level courses without registering for a full diploma or degree programme, must satisfy relevant entry requirements. 5.0 DEADLINES FOR ADMISSION

Completed applications should be returned to the Admissions Office of the relevant campus (see addresses listed on page 6) on or prior to the published deadline (see daily newspapers and our website). Applications submitted after the deadline dates may still be considered, subject to availability of places.

6.0 FEES

All applicants must pay a TT\$25.00 non-refundable application fee to defray administrative processing costs. There is a limit to the number of programmes that an applicant may apply for on a single form. Additional forms will incur a separate processing fee. The College reserves the right to review costs for the processing applications for admission at any time.
